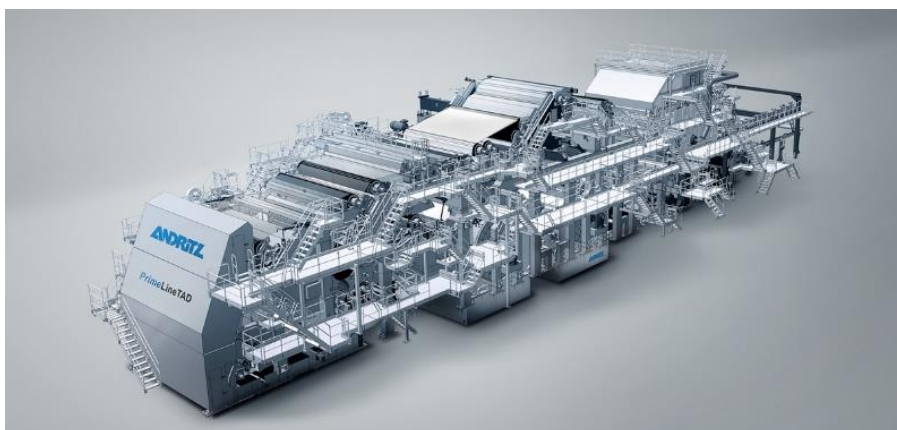
ANDRITZ experts will hold conference speeches at the fair with focus on the following topics:
