ANDRITZ developed a threading solution for both machines that will fully automate the process to increase the safety for the operators and decrease the web break time to gain a higher productivity.

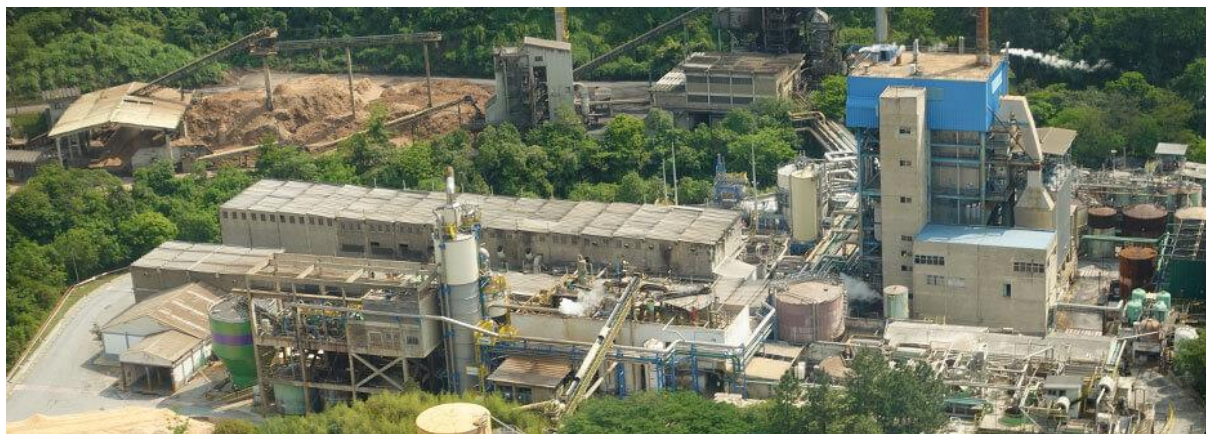
As a leading supplier of threading technology, ANDRITZ offers safe solutions that keep operators away from the machine and reduce total threading time.
