ANDRITZ to upgrade continuous galvanizing line for Tangsteel, China

GRAZ, MAY 21, 2025. International technology group ANDRITZ has received an order from Tangsteel High Strength Automotive Strip Co., Ltd. to upgrade and modernize the existing No. 5 Continuous Galvanizing Line (TAN-CGL5) at its facility in Tangshan, Hebei Province, China. Following the upgrade, the line will be able to cover a wider production range and higher steel grades for automotive applications. Commissioning is scheduled for the fourth quarter of 2025.

The No. 5 Continuous Galvanizing Line is a key production line for high-strength automotive steel at Tangsteel. Originally commissioned in 2017, it was previously upgraded by ANDRITZ in 2021 to enhance its heating and cooling capacity. The line primarily produced material used for high-end applications in the automotive and home appliance industries.

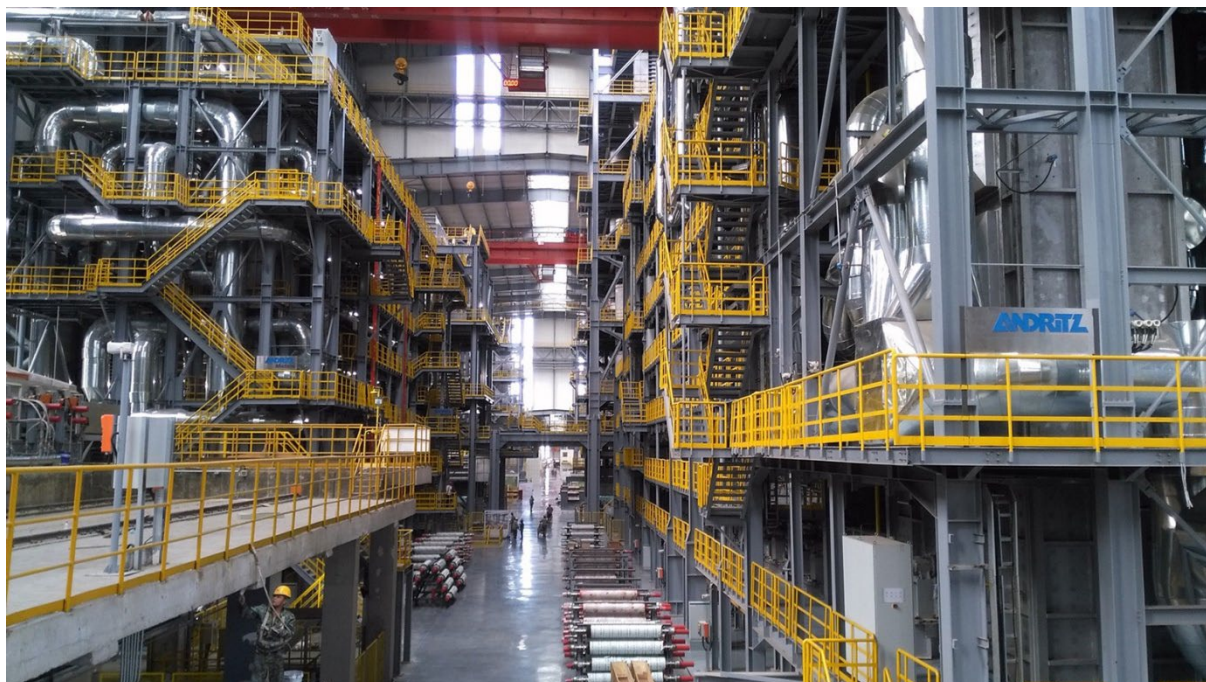
